Natural structures for playgrounds [Sue Gallant]:

Sue Gallant joined to present the benefits of natural playscapes. Through extensive study of play, and touring schools who've built such playsapes, Sue and others have fully realized the tremendous benefits that natural structures provide to the cognitive development and engagement of children. Naturalization of the pre-k playground will begin this year. Further consideration of whether to plan for a natural playscape for Jameson/Loranger will be explored by the new Playground Committee.
