## **Principal's Report**

## **Jameson update** [Ms. Fletcher]:

- Halloween week was filled with lots of energy and fun!
- The focus of the teacher workshop on Tuesday, 11/8 is around raising engagement in the classroom (cooperative games, social learning), revisiting progress checks and goals, and improving playground interactions.
- The 1<sup>st</sup> grade recently participated in a mock election—creating GoNoodle "candidates", delivering speeches and participating in practice voting. It was a fun experience.
- Barbara attended a PLC meeting in Augusta that focused on play time and social learning.
  She will be working with an architect to survey the land and provide some ideas of what can be done (at a minimal cost) to improve the playgrounds at Jameson and Loranger.
  More information to come in December.
- Jameson has two foster grandparents (through the Opportunity Alliance) who are making connections with the little ones in the school.

## Jameson/Loranger update [Mr. Flaherty]:

- The focus of the teacher workshop on Tuesday, 11/8 is around Science and Social Studies planning and increasing student engagement.
- The 6<sup>th</sup> grade class just returned from a successful week at Camp Kiev.
- Winter Sports season is starting up for grades 6/7/8.
- NWA testing (universal screening) is underway for grades 6/7/8. This testing provides great insight into where students may need more enrichment.
