 Administrators will reach out to a couple other schools who have received this presentation and request feedback. They may also consider looking into other options with Office Porter.

- A decision should be made soon—all are encouraged to reflect on the presentation and come prepared at the 1/4 meeting to have a roundtable and reach a decision

Loranger update [Mr. Flaherty]:

- The combined K-8 assembly took place the week before Thanksgiving. The middle school band played and the 2nd grade class sang. Lots of moving parts and logistical planning to make this happen. The next combined assembly is scheduled for **Monday**, 12/21 at 11:45 come check it out!
- Teachers have recently been given some leeway in supplementing the math program to help students develop math computation skills (this flexibility didn't exist when we were part of the RSU).
- Due to a unique student population, a new Special Ed teacher has come on board at Jameson. Welcome, Jen MacDonald!
- Jameson/Loranger have two new custodians and we're seeing a great benefit already.
- Surrounding school districts are inquiring about our restorative practices work and wanting to observe and learn from us.

Jameson/Loranger update [Mr. Shabo]:
