Principal's Report

John Suttie (OOBHS Principal and Superintendent), stopped by to introduce himself. If you have any questions or concerns for him, feel free to call him at OOBHS.

Jameson update [Ms. Fletcher]:

- It's been a smooth transition back to school with 1st and 2nd graders returning the week of 9/4 and pre-K and K starting the week of 9/11.
- The Day of Caring took place on Saturday, 9/10. Volunteers did a lot of weeding, digging, and organizing—resulting in a new flower bed at the front of the school, a new picnic table, and organized closets. Volunteers also donated backpacks stuffed with supplies for kids who are in need.

Jameson/Loranger update [Mr. Flaherty]:

- The year is off to an awesome start. There has been some fluctuation in enrollment—with lower numbers of students enrolled in 5th-8th grades. An influx of new students is anticipated in the next month or so but for now, class sizes are very manageable.
- Loranger has welcomed some new faculty this school year:
 - Ms. Fagan (grade 3 in the modular unit)
 - Ms. Galipeau (LEAP*). LEAP (learn, empower, achieve, progress) is a project based course that includes meditation, self-defense, yoga, etc. Ms. Galipeau comes to us with experience as a private investigator, yoga instructor, physical education teacher, and paralegal.
 - Ms. York (Ed Tech in the behavior program for grades 3, 4, 5)
- Report cards will be standards-based for 6th grade this year.
- The first early release day is scheduled for 9/14. Faculty will be hard at work on curriculum, making sure standards are clear, and student engagement methods.
- Due to limited resources, there is no longer a late bus. We're currently working with the Recreation Department to see if their bus might be an option.

*LEAP has taken the place of French this year. An exhaustive search for a new foreign language teacher yielded no qualified applicants. The goal is to bring a foreign language program back to Loranger in the spring.

Hydration Stations – Kristin Zecchinelli:

Discussed this refrigerated and filtered water bottle filling station/water fountain all-in-one:

- There are many advantages to a system like this, and it might be a more economical solution to replacing failing water fountains.
- Lee Koenigs (past PTO member) was gracious in sharing information about the fixture installed at Libby Memorial Library: list price is \$1600 for one unit plus installation. Actual cost hovers around the \$1,000 mark plus installation. Filters last for up to 10,000 water bottle fills.
- Discussed looking into budgeting for a unit next year (potential replacement for water cooler as well). We might also be able to leverage <u>donorschoose.org</u> and/or <u>gofundme.com</u> for donations.

- This preK-2 event will take place in the Jameson gym on Friday, 9/23 at 6:30 p.m.
- Teresa will loan copy of Zootopia to be shown on the new Jameson projector.
