

Superintendent's Report

Superintendent Suttie stated we received a very generous gift yesterday from Paul Landry from Landry's Hannaford and Julie Bayley from Bayley's Camping Resort of gift cards that will benefit 70 of our families in RSU 23. Once again, I cannot say thank you to the community enough. We had a nice cash donation from Biddeford Saco Savings this week and we had a little ceremony with them on Tuesday and thanked them for their donation. The community has continuously stepped up in helping those in need. For the COVID 19 update; we went on a hot streak from the start of school until Thanksgiving and then we had 11 positive tests and all three schools were classified by outbreaks by the CDC so we ended up having a couple of meetings with those folks. An outbreak is when you have 3 or more cases that are linked in a week. No additional cases have occurred. Interestingly, in the meetings with the CDC there is a shift in their emphasis where they are telling us that kids are safer in schools and they wanted us to do what we can to keep them open. Over Christmas break Waltz and Sons will be installing touchless bathroom facilities in all three of our schools. We are able to use the CRF funds for that cost. We are excited to have them come do that during the break. Since this will be the last meeting of the year and a very unique and trying year, I want to give big thank you's to the custodial staff and food service, maintenance, and bus drivers for all the work they have done. I am very proud of the way our district work to collaborate over the summer to create a strong back to school plan. I want to thank the education association for their work alongside of us in creating that plan. I am appreciative of all the work that Mark Beaudoin did early on getting the jump on other districts on purchasing and securing all of the PPE. I am proud of technology team, which has gone above and beyond in a time where we had to learn how to teach remotely on the fly and all the support that is required by those people. A lot of shinning bright stars emerged in our school district during this time. It has been quite an amazing thing and someday look back on it and be proud at what we did to make it all work in 2020. 
Committee Reports

Finance: Dave stated they met this morning on a lot of things. First thing we talked about was the audit. I can assure you that the items that were brought up, we talked about and there is a plan in place to present to the Finance committee on how we will strengthen those areas. Our budget was phenomenal. Everyone has issues that we have. With COVID it was a challenging ½ year and we understand that. We also talked about retirement incentives and there were some areas that were offered to us if there were different amounts being offered and how it would affect the budget. The finance committee has decided and is making a recommendation that we will revisit it in February and anything we may know from the state. We will be in a better position to make a decision when we get that information. He gave an update on our Coronavirus relief funds.

Building: Peter stated they have not met this month but we are on the calendar now moving forward. I am looking forward to the next meeting.

Technology: Donna stated that they met and talked mostly about the challenges COVID brought us in Spring 2020. What that is important, I began to realize how much technology we have in our district and how important it is. Every student, teacher, supervisor, and administrator in our district has a device or two that needs to be maintained. Counting students and staff we have over 800 devices. Counting everything this department is responsible for aside from devices like apple tv, smart boards and projectors, it's a big job even for a small district. I can tell just from listening to Pam that the pressure is on every day. Our technology department is a four-person team. They deal with every program, makes repairs and deals with any issues as they arise as well as with the remote learning students. We are using COVID money to purchase additional tools for teachers to use while teaching remotely such as document cameras and web cams. They are also providing hotspots for students to use who do not have internet while learning from home. We are also upgrading elementary student ipads and teacher computers. They have also made improvement to the WIFI network in the district. The technology director is creating and implementing a permission/responsibility and procedure form that will be ready before the next school year. The department also offers families device insurance. I would like to thank
