Dear Staff, Students, and Families,

This letter is to inform you that an individual associated with Loranger Memorial School recently tested positive for Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). The individual was last present at school September 10. The district has conducted contact tracing and has identified **five** people as close contacts. **Four** individuals have met the criteria for being exempted from quarantine. An individual can be exempted through vaccination, previous COVID infection, universal masking, or pooled testing. **One** individual will need to be quarantined as a result of this case.

A school representative has contacted those students and staff members identified as close contacts of the individual who tested positive. Close contacts have been asked to quarantine for 10 days from last exposure. A negative test result does not remove the need for a close contact to quarantine.

Please monitor yourself for signs and symptoms and call a healthcare provider if symptoms start. Stay home if you are sick.

Maine CDC recommends prevention measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19. These measures include proper handwashing with soap and warm water, which is especially important after using the bathroom, before eating, and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing. When soap and water is not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60 percent alcohol. Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands and avoid close contact with people who are sick. Cover your cough or sneeze into a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash. Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.
